Dear Lakes Families,

It is hard to believe that the end of October is upon us! Please see last minute reminders for the Trunk-or-Treat event that is being held this afternoon below. A map for parking is also attached.

On Tuesday, October 31, we will be having some Halloween fun...costumes, class parties and our parade! Classroom teachers have sent home specific information about class parties and costume wear. Please remember our school-wide costume guidelines:

-Keep the costumes as simple as possible so students will be able to manage them independently. Include an extra bag for students to pack costumes in at the end of the day.

-Costumes are to be non-violent and age appropriate. They should not be frightening in nature nor should they be degrading in any way to culture, religion or race.

-Props, such as swords, wands, brooms, weapons, etc. are not allowed. These items can often pose a safety hazard.

-If your child's costume includes face paint, it must be applied at home before school. Masks may be worn during the parade and may be worn during classroom parties at the discretion of the teacher.

If you are interested in viewing our costumed kiddos, our parade will begin around 1:30pm. To view the parade, please park in the Lakes or Farms lot and then line the bus loop. DO NOT park in the bus loop or on the grass. Students will parade out along the bus loop and then back into the building. Parade viewing for parents will be outside. We are asking for pictures/videos of the parade to be limited to just your child(en). Only parents that are signed up as classroom party volunteers will be joining our staff and students inside during the day. Thank you for your support; we are looking forward to a fun day!
