## Lakes Students are KIND!

Daily instruction at Lakes includes more than just the content areas of reading, writing, math, social studies and science. We also teach lots of other skills too. This month we focus on social awareness...specifically, KINDNESS!!!! All students will be explicitly taught what it means to be kind, things they can do to spread kindness, and what to do if/when someone isn't being kind. Ask your student(s) what they have been learning!

#### State Testing

Next week, 3rd and 4th grade students will be taking the Smarter Balanced Interim Assessment. Students will take this type of assessment 3 times during this school year (beginning of the year, winter and then M-STEP in the spring). We use these assessments as one measure of student growth. Student score reports will be sent home once the testing cycle is complete. Assessments are taken in the students classroom as part of their normal school day activities; no advance preparation is needed. This provides an important baseline to determine student growth.
